KEYNOTE SPEAKER, Dr. Claudia Probst, *Department of Plant Pathology, College of Agricultural, Human, and Natural Resource Sciences, Washington State University.* Dr. Probst's research in the identification of specific factors that promote fruit infection, and the improvement of existing and new disease management approaches, will provide local cherry growers with important current information on the control of powdery mildew, a known threat occurring in this area. Dr. Probst will also discuss other plant pathogens specific to sweet cherries which may include topics such as brown rot and little cherry virus. Dr. Probst will be available to answer questions during her presentations before and after the lunch break.
