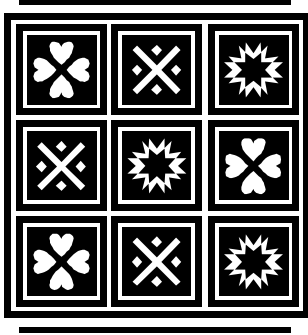

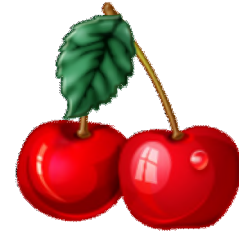

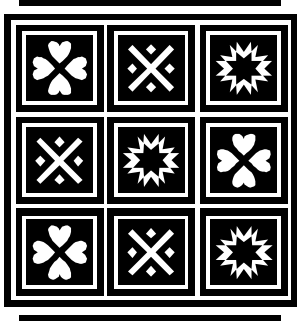

Quilt Contest Rules & Regulations

1. We are proud of our unique resource, the Montana Sweet Cherry. Cherries are the theme of our contest, so cherry themed fabric or a depiction of cherries in the piecing or appliqué is required.
 2. All cherry themed quilts will be accepted. We encourage you to enter cherry quilts that you have entered before----our goal is to deck the town of Polson with cherry quilts! Also, antique cherry quilts would be great!
 3. **Entries are due at All in Stitches quilt store on July 9.** Entries will be displayed in the downtown windows July 10-18. They may be picked up on the afternoon of the 19th (Monday). If you wish, you may mail the quilt to the quilt store with a return prepaid UPS label.
 4. Each entry must have an entry form attached to it (see below), with complete details, including the entrant's phone number and address.
 5. Judging will be done by **Viewer's Choice Voting.** Ballots can be picked up and dropped off at All in Stitches and Jackie M's Footwear stores. Voting closes on Sunday at noon.
- Prizes will be gift certificates awarded on Sunday, July 18. **\$100 for 1st Prize (All In Stitches) \$50 for 2nd Prize (Wildhorse Island Quilting) \$50 for 3rd Prize (Montana Quilt Connection) and \$50**
